**W**orking in the core of Winnipeg with Siloam Mission, I see a lot of things, and not much surprises me after a while. Sometimes it is easy to become calloused and miss things. The expectancy of failure is often reinforced by failures of the ones I so desperately want to see succeed. But every so often God reminds me why I started working with the less fortunate.

I have moved from the front lines to working with MOST (Mission: Off the Street Team). I have enjoyed focusing on a small group and working with them to develop their self-worth. MOST is a group of individuals committing themselves to the program for a variety of reasons. Every day they go out, either picking up garbage from the street or, in winter, shovelling snow. They are relentless in their efforts, and it has been a joy to watch.

Every morning the team starts to roll into my office. They are tired and carrying their morning cup of coffee. We do a little joking around, fill in their time sheets for

the day, and talk about concerns that need to be addressed, and then decide which area of downtown we will look after that day.

After all this is done, we open the Bible and begin our reading of one chapter a day. We do this every morning to improve their ability to communicate in a group and develop their confidence.

When I took a week of holidays I left them to fend for themselves. This is the part that excites me: They continued to meet every morning for their usual routine...and they continued the Scripture reading without any prompting! Amazing!

Pray that I and others involved in this ministry will show them the love of Christ and His life-changing truths, which can permanently change their destiny. Pray that God's Word will not return void and that the seeds planted will continue to grow.


